CHUCK WALLACH, C.E.O. of Bio-Energy Services, discusses and *demonstrates* "**The PAP Ion Magnetic Inductor (Pap-Imi) - A Promising New Wellness Electronics Technology**". This brilliant and innovative new healing device generates an intense magnetic field that produces 2-3 micro-lightning pulses every second. These pulses are powerful enough to fuse metal and discerning enough to penetrate deep tissue in ways which can result in significant pain reduction and accelerated healing for a number of ailments and injuries.
